 2. Form must be submitted to massusagcommittee@aol.com and invitational meet director via email no later than the Tuesday preceding the Invitational.
 3. Check for \$5.00 per gymnast is postmarked by the Tuesday preceding the invitational and sent to Michele Archer, checks payable to USA Gymnastics-MA.
 4. After the fact declarations (forgot to list someone), will incur a \$25.00 late fee

- Event Specialists
 - Mobility through levels 7-9 is an 8.5
 - Declaration date to be a specialist is one month prior to state championships in writing to SACC with events noted.
 - Gymnast needs an 8.7 twice in any qualifying meet to qualify for states
 - To qualify to 9/10 Regionals, gymnast needs to score a 9.0 at states
 - There is no opportunity for Level 7, 8 or Xcel gymnasts event specialists to qualify to Regionals.

- After hosting a meet...(mobility meets too)
 - Return sanction to USA Gymnastics
 - Copy of page #2 ONLY of sanction and \$1.00 per gymnast payable to USAG Region 6 and sent to Kathy Ostberg
 - PTF sent to massusagcommittee@aol.com (must be done by the Wednesday following the competition)

- Awards
 - Achievement ribbons no longer a requirement at any level.
- Level 1-3/XB 100% Awards?
 - Theme/Invitationals/States – 100% AA of something – does not have to be a trophy. (States will be doing champions medals), placements for events (states @ 40% for Xcel as R&P, theme/inv recommended 50%)
- State awards – 35% for events and AA for Levels 1-10
- New for Level 9/10 – Out of state meets will be allowed for qualification to states. A 34.00AA must be attained, a copy of the meet results as well as a copy of the sanction or sanction # must be sent to massusagcommittee@aol.com.
- JO gymnasts that are repeating the same level that they competed at states last season may directly enter a sectional competition (no pre-sectional necessary).
- If using an out of state meet as a qualifier to sectionals, or a Level 9/10 qualifying to states, please submit the official scores and sanction number to massusagcommittee@aol.com at the conclusion of the event.
